The Alesis GRIP is a sub-harmonic synthesizer that adds deep bass to stereo signals. Unlike an EQ, which indiscriminately boosts bass frequencies that may be loud enough already, the GRIP automatically analyzes the bass content of the music, and then resynthesizes the low end to harmonically match—even creating new frequencies where none existed before. The result is full, clear bass—never muddle.

Three 16-segment LED meters provide details on input level, gain reduction, and bass level. A separate crossover output allows direct connection to a subwoofer.

Positioning

The Alesis GRIP is an easy, powerful, and affordable way to increase bass frequencies in a way that harmonically matches the music, as well as manage bass for optimal speaker amplification.

The GRIP is the perfect bass management system for DJs, dance club setups, large PA systems, car audio, home theater systems, and bass guitar rigs.
