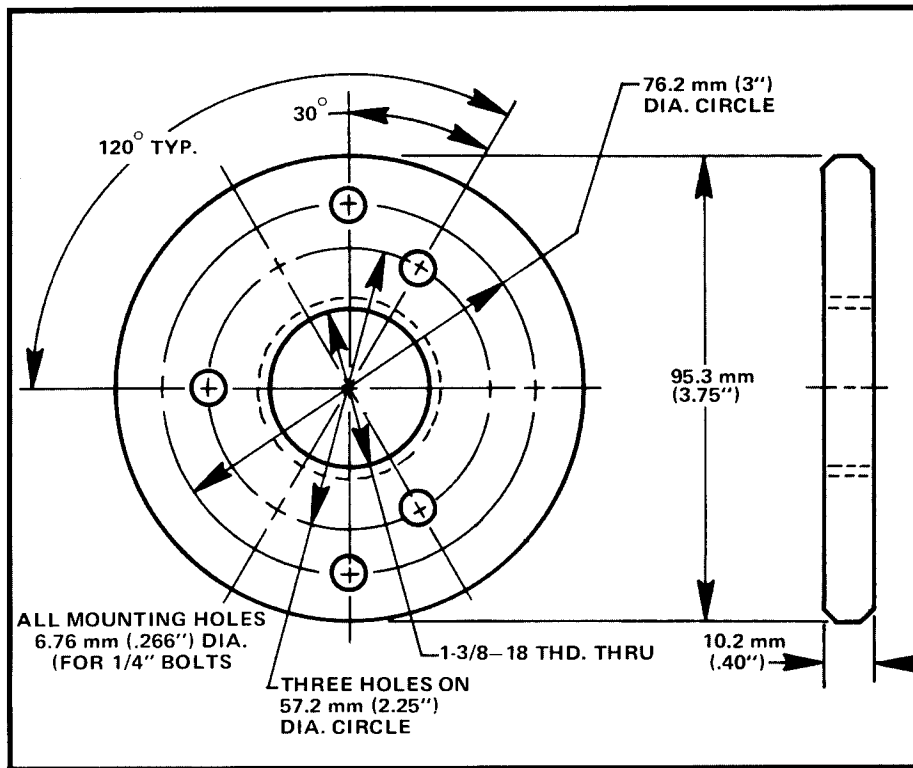

## ADH-2 Driver-to-Horn Adapter

### DESCRIPTION

The Electro-Voice Model ADH-2 is designed to adapt any of the Electro-Voice screw-in drivers with  $1\frac{3}{8}$ "-18 thread (with nominal inside neck diameters of approximately  $\frac{7}{8}$ " to the Altec and JBL horns or horns with 1-inch nominal throat diameter and with two- or three-hole mounting pattern ( $\frac{1}{4}$ " bolt). The possible Electro-Voice drivers are the 1824 series, 1828 series, 1829 series, DH2mt, DH2Amt, and the DH1506. It should be noted that the nominal driver mouth area and horn (or horn adapter) areas may not be of comparable size; however, it has been found that from the practical standpoint the mismatch and resulting aberrations provided are of rather academic interest only, particularly for the more inexpensive drivers.
