Just a FYI

I recently ran into an end user looking for a 70.7V transformer for the 7110XC driver. Here is the information I found that will work:

You can use the transformer that comes standard in the ID30CT - The part number to order is 56-05-022-109. List 31.20 Cost 20.80. The customer will have to open the driver and wire it himself, but it will physically fit and properly function.

The only reason I mention this is because the spec sheet mentions a 5030 transformer, which has a actual part number of 56-05-023-784. The customer I talked to was replacing existing transformers in his drivers, and the 5030 was not what was originally installed into the driver.
