

### **Horn Mounting Kit**

- Mounts HP9040 horn on top of TL606DW low-frequency system
- Allows horizontal and vertical horn orientation

#### **DESCRIPTION**

The HMK-2 horn mounting kit allows the HP9040 horn to be mounted to the TL606DW low-frequency system, with horizontal and vertical rotational freedom.

#### MOUNTING

Bolts and T-nuts have been preinstalled in the TL606DW. Together with the hardware supplied with the kit, the horn and driver can be easily mounted to the enclosure as shown.

The mounting board has two sets of mounting holes. The first is used for mounting the horn mouth flush with the front of the woofer enclo-

sure. The second set positions the horn mouth nine inches in front of the woofer enclosure and allows the horn to be rotated ±25° in the horizontal plane as shown in the diagram above.

#### FIGURE1 - HMK-2 Board, Top View, Horn Flush with Cabinet




FIGURE 2 — HMK-2 Board, Top View, Horn Extended from Cabinet (for fixed horn position)





FIGURE 3 — HMK-2 Board, Top View, Horn Extended from Cabinet (for lateral horn rotation)



#### **HMK-2 INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

#### Horn flush with cabinet

- 1. Remove indicated bolts [ ] from cabinet (see Figure 1).
- 2. Using removed bolts, secure HMK-2 board flush with front of cabinet.
- 3. Bolt driver to horn, attach adjustable bracket assembly to lower hole in horn throat (see Figure 4).
- Secure board bracket (item 9) to rear of HMK-2 board
  , using supplied short bolt. Note: bolts will not penetrate through board to cabinet.
- Secure horn/adjustable bracket assembly to front brackets and rear board bracket using hardware supplied (see Figure 4).
- 7. Adjust tilt angle required by bending small brackets at front of horn.

#### Horn extended from cabinet (for fixed horn position)

- 1. Remove indicated bolts [ ) from cabinet (see Figure 2).
- Using removed bolts, sécurè HMK-2 board six inches forward of cabinet front.
- 3. Continue as in "flush" installation.
- 4. Horn will not rotate.

#### Horn extended from cabinet (for lateral horn roatation)

- 1. Remove indicated bolts [ ] from cabinet (see Figure 3).
- Using removed bolts, secure HMK-2 board nine inches forward of cabinet front.
- 3. Continue as in "flush" installation.
- 4. Horn/board assembly will permit lateral rotation.
