Problem	Suggestion
Green LED does not indicate camera power is turned on.	Make sure the Power Adapter is plugged into a wall outlet and the main video cable of the camera.
	Check all cable connections to verify they are tight and fully inserted.
Green LED is on, but no picture appears on the screen.	Verify the lens cover has been removed.
	Is the TV/VCR set to the correct channel for live input? Refer to the TV/VCR owners manual.
Audio is weak, and/or excessive feedback is heard.	Is the person speaking too far from the base of the camera or at the rear of the base?
	The camera microphone should ideally be positioned behind the speakers being used. This will help eliminate feedback.
	Verify the audio out cable from the camera is plugged into a line-in jack. If a mic-in jack is used, you will experience more feedback and other noise.
Camera will not focus automatically.	Make sure the camera is not in manual focus mode by pressing the 'auto' button on the remote control.
	When using maximum zoom capabilities, the camera cannot focus on objects closer to the lens than 3 feet.
Images on the LCD screen appear distorted, and/or colors are inaccurate.	Use the control knobs on the rear of the base to adjust the screen as desired.
	LCD screens have a limited range of visibility. Attempting to view the picture too far from the side may result in an unsatisfactory image.
The remote control does not work	Verify fresh batteries are installed and in the correct position
