

TS612 Drop-in Module Instruction Sheet

Introduction

The TS612 Drop-in Module provides the full set of TS612 control-surface features on a convenient panel that mounts within your audio console. This module can be installed vertically or side-by-side (if split module version) to maximize space.

This instruction sheet provides step-by-step instructions for installing all configurations of the TS612 Drop-in Module. For set up or operation instructions, refer to the **TS612 Installation and Operations Manual**.

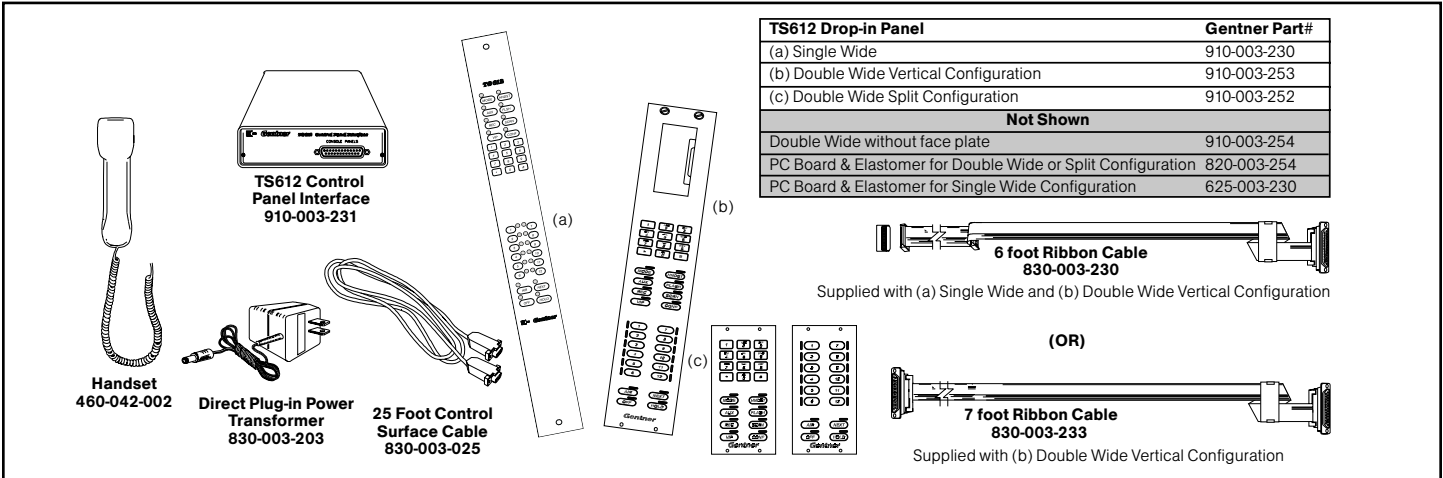


Figure 1. Equipment diagram.

Power Requirements

The Control panel interface Requires 12VDC at 500mA.

Equipment Placement

The TS612 Drop-in Module should be placed directly into a vacant slot within your audio console. The TS612 Control Panel Interface (CPI) should be placed within 7 feet of the drop-in module.

Note: The CPI and 7-foot ribbon cable should be placed away from critical analog circuits to prevent digital signals from interfering with analog signals.

Audio Console Preparation

The TS612 Drop-in Module fits standard single- or double-wide channel slots (depending on selection). Remove the cover from the blank channel insert of your console according to the manufacturer's instructions.

Installation

The TS612 Drop-in Module is used in place of the standard TS612 Control Surface.

Completed Installation

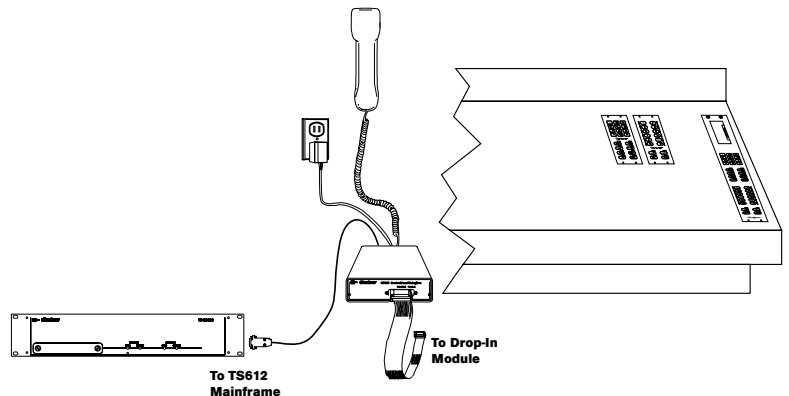


Figure 2. Properly installed TS612 Drop-in Module system.

Figure 2 shows the TS612 Drop-in Module when installation is complete. Follow these step-by-step instructions to install the TS612 Drop-in Module:

Step 1

Identify where you will mount the TS612 Drop-in Module in your audio console.

Step 2

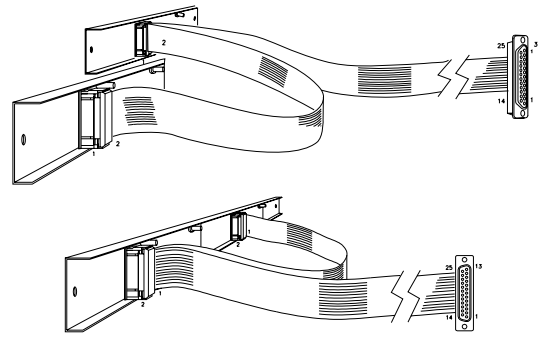


Figure 3. Ribbon cable attachment.

Attach the ribbon cable to the TS612 Drop-in Module (Figure 3). To ensure correct power polarity, ensure that pin 1 (red) wire is connected to pin 1 on the TS612 Drop-in Module PCBs.

Step 3

Thread the D connector end of the ribbon cable out through the opening in the back of the audio console.

Step 4

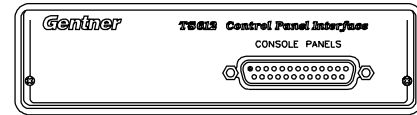


Figure 4. Console Panel ribbon cable attachment.

Connect the D connector end of the ribbon cable to the front of the TS612 CPI (Figure 4) at the 25-pin port labeled CONSOLE PANELS.

Step 5

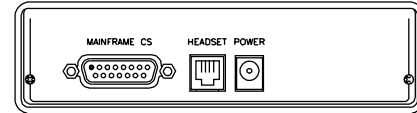


Figure 5. Mainframe Control Surface cable attachment.

Attach the power cable to the CPI's POWER port (Figure 5).

Step 6

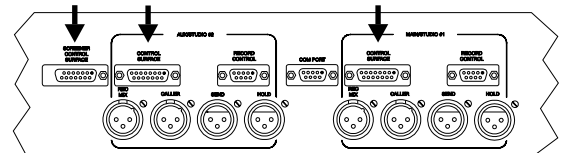


Figure 6. Serial cable mainframe attachment.

Attach the 25-foot control-surface cable from the back of the CPI at the port labeled MAINFRAME CS (Figure 5) to the appropriate TS612 mainframe control surface port (Figure 6).

Step 7

Connect the handset to the CPI's HEADSET port (Figure 5).

Note: Because the ribbon cable is parallel, it does not matter which 20-pin IDC connector is attached at the top of the Drop-in Module.

Operation Note: The TS612 Drop-in Module provides the same operational features as the standard TS612 Control Surface except that

the MUTE button has been replaced with a button labeled HNDSET. When selected, this button activates handset mode and the Handset LED glows green.

Warranty
