

Kensington solution for attaching MAX phones to table



The basic idea is to fasten the security slot adapter, which comes with a strong adhesive, to one of the two upper flat surfaces on the MAX phone, and then connect any of the standard Kensington cable locking systems to that slot. Information on procuring the security slot adapter, along with two suggestions for cable locks is listed below:

Again, the same idea – fasten the Secure-It Glue-On Disc, which comes included with Loctite (with an advertised pull force of 4000 lbs), to one of the two upper flat surfaces on the MAX phone, and then connect any of the standard Secure-It cable locking systems to that disc.
