To All Employees & Staff of G&L Guitars:

First off, I must admit that I do usually not write to any company (Other than to complain), But I must take exception here.

In early 1999 I began wanting a new guitar. Something special, out of the ordinary, possibly have something built by either a small luthier or one of the large custom shops. As the year went by I was introduced to your instruments by Joe Mullens at Performance Music Center of Woburn, MA. When I asked about getting a custom made guitar, he carefully explained the options and availability that you offer, as well as a brief history of your company. No matter what option I asked about, Joe just smiled, and said "No Problem". After playing a few of your fine guitars I decided on a ASAT Special, in a blueburst finish with a matching headstock. I was most amazed by the turnaround time "About 8 weeks or so". Most custom shops and luthiers were telling me "Around 12 to 18 months" .I was very pleasantly surprised when it came in less than 5 weeks.

I have never been happier with any guitar I've purchased. The finish is flawless, the workmanship impeccable and it plays like a dream. I used it on a recording session this past week, and the engineer was amazed with the sound, and the good comments kept rolling in all night.

I've included a picture of my ASAT, but I have to say that pictures don't do it Justice, nor does an inkjet printer.

I must say my hat is off to everyone at G&L, your instruments are obviously made with alot of Precision, care and love. I have played guitar for over 12 years, and I have yet to play anything like my ASAT, and I'm not going to wait another 12 years for my next one
