

# **BC-10A Instruction Sheet**

## Introduction

The BC-10A Battery Charger is designed to recharge Gentner's portable ALS receivers, RX-1A and RX-6, and PTX Portable Transmitter when using AA Ni-Cad (Nickel-Cadmium) rechargeable batteries.

The battery charger is designed with 10 different pockets, each with its own dedicated charging circuit. It can charge from one to 10 Gentner units at a time, maintaining adequate charging for each unit.

### **Product Description**

The BC-10A (See Figure 1, right.) was designed for ease in operation. There are no adjustments to make: the unit is plug and play.

1. *Charger Housing*. The BC-10A houses 10 charging pockets for ALS receivers and portable transmitters.

2. *Power Supply*. The AC adaptor plugs into any standard electrical outlet.

3. *Charging Pockets.* Ten slots allow for placement of receivers and/or portable transmitters.

4. *LED*. A small LED at each pocket glows red while batteries are charging.

#### Setup

To set up the BC-10A for operation, perform the following three steps:

## Step 1

Place the battery charger on a flat surface.

### Step 2

Connect the power-supply cord to the left side of the charger (Figure 1, above).

### Step 3

Plug the AC adaptor into a standard electrical outlet.

### Operation

To recharge a unit, perform the following two steps:

### Step 1

Turn the receiver or transmitter OFF before placing it in the battery charger.


#### Step 2




Figure 2. Gentner unit placement

Firmly place the RX-1A, RX-6 or PTX inside any available charging pockets (Figure 2, right).

The LED in front of the pocket will glow red, indicating that charging is taking place.

### LED NOTE:

If the LED does not light up, ensure that the power supply is plugged firmly into the wall outlet. The jack at the other of the cord should be tightly connected to the charger. Check for correct battery polarity and press the receiver and/or transmitter firmly into the pocket.

## **Battery Charging Duration**

Fully depleted batteries require approximately 18 hours to recharge.

#### **RECHARGING NOTE:**

Recharge units using only Ni-Cad rechargeable batteries. Alkaline batteries will case damage to the BC-10A batter charger. Also, do not exceed 60 hours of continuous charging. This may cause damage to the batteries and/or product.

## Warranty

Gentner Communications Corporation (Manufacturer) warrants that this Assistive Listening System (ALS) product is free of defects in both materials and workmanship. Should any part of this equipment be defective, Manufacturer agrees, at its option, to:

A. Repair or replace any defective ALS product, free of charge (except transportation charges), for a period of one year from the date of the original purchase, provided the owner returns the equipment to the Manufacturer at the address set forth below. No charge will be made for parts or labor during this period;

B. Furnish replacement for any defective ALS product parts in the equipment for a period of one year from the date of original purchase. Replacement parts shall be furnished without charge, except labor and transportation;

C. Repair or replace any defective ALS accessory, free of charge (except transportation charges), for a period of 60 days from the date of the original purchase, provided the owner returns the equipment to the Manufacturer at the address set forth below. Adaptations or accessories other than those manufactured or provided by Manufacturer have been made or attached to the equipment which, in the determination of Manufacturer, shall have affected the performance, safety or reliability of the equipment; or,

D. The equipment's original serial number has been modified or removed.

This warranty does not cover damage to the equipment during shipment and Manufacturer assumes no responsibility for such damage. All shipping costs shall be paid by customer. This warranty extends only to the original purchaser and is not assignable or transferable.
