Changing Preset Selection:

The Digital-6 Plus is equipped with six preset memory channels, it is set to across the Assistive Listening Band selected for best overall performance:

Memory	Factory Setting	Frequency
1	Channel 2	72.10 MHz
2	Channel 10	72.50 MHz
3	Channel 19	72.95 MHz
4	Channel 21	74.70 MHz
5	Channel 28	75.50 MHz
6	Channel 36	75.90 MHz

You may change the presets by following the stepby-step instructions. (See page 8 for frequencies corresponding to other channels.) The Digital-6 Plus receiver is digitally tuned. Once a channel is selected, no further adjustments are necessary.

Step1

Make sure that the keypad lock is turned off, by following the steps mentioned in "KEYPAD LOCK" instructions.

Step2

By using the "UP" or "DOWN" button to select one out of six memory <u>pre-sets</u> which is to be changed. The current memory channel is displayed on the lower left corner of the LCD screen underneath the letter "M".

Step3

To change the current memory channel, press the button "MW". The small letter "M" will start to flash, and one of the 37 channels used in the Assistive Listening Band will appear on the LCD screen center, press "Func" key will show the
