

The VC5 concept

The JOEMEEK 'Meequalizer' is a two channel, line level equalizer with a difference. That being its design was inspired by Ted Fletcher's early 70's mixing desk designs to have an EQ effect that was pleasing to the ear, and not necessarily having the same effect or response curves as ordinary EQ's. The VC5 has been built to give the most aggressive, powerful sound possible, while maintaining a signal's musical harmonic properties.

The key to producing an EQ with tonal qualities beyond any digital or modern op amp based design is simplicity. Don't worry about db/octave predictability, or precise frequency responses, or even have too many bands and shelving controls. These things have no place in the mind of the sound engineer who has to produce the right sound for the job. The Meequalizer has the sound, and that is all that matters. How is this possible? The VC5 uses a vintage design class A amplifier at the heart of the EQ sections. 



The very first equalisers were designed for the motion picture industry. The problem that had to be overcome was that different scenes had to be shot with the dialogue microphone different distances from the person speaking; so they needed a piece of equipment that 'equalized' the sound, not just the volume. These early equalisers were naturally very musical and 'easy' sounding and that is the basis of the JOEMEEK VC5V2. By experimenting and going 'over the top' with some of the electronics, the resulting sound possibilities are musical, aggressive and highly creative.



Conventional equalisers were developed from the theory of what 'should' happen when the knobs are turned. In practice, they fail to sound right because the designers did not have the background of knowledge in the practicalities of real sound creation. The curves may look pretty, but we are just not interested in listening to curves!



As with the early EQ's the controls are all highly interactive in the interests of musicality. What results is the phase shift shelving VC5 Meequalizer, an EQ that sounds right!





The SC4 bridges the gap between the sounds of the photo electric cell and the basic accuracy of VCA compressor designs and allows direct and easy linking with analogue and digital systems. Included are M&S/Left/Right 'superbal' analogue inputs and L/R 'superbal' outputs that may be run alongside the 24bit AES/EBU and optical interfaces. The digital I/O will also sync to any bit rate and resolution, but also has the ability to perform 'perfect' sample rate conversion (as the signal path is via analogue).

Middle and Side

The use of M&S in the SC4 is a method of guaranteeing perfect image accuracy. Even highly dynamic program material will not cause the SC4 to distort the delicate stereo image of a mix. The SC4 achieves this through the use of M&S within the compression cycle to make a mix insensitive to any subtle dynamic differences between the light cells. This gives

the compressor a feeling of the classic JOEMEEK with perfect image and control, even when sounds are highly dynamic and moving in the L/R domain. The SC4 is also equipped with an M/S switch on the inputs, allowing a bypass of the M/S matrix. This means that location sound and general stereo recording can be achieved and compressed at once by using the unit in part as a M/S - L/R converter. Access to the M/S signal is possible at all times through the SC4's M/S insert points that, with appropriate processing, can be used to create spatial effects at the final mix stage.

Application

The SC4 is perfect for the professional studio user that needs final 2 track or submix compression on any demanding program material. The advantages of the SC4 are even greater for users of digital systems as the SC4 is equipped with seamless 24 bit D/A and A/D converters with multi sample rate capability. However, the greatest benefit to such digital or hybrid systems is the compression sound itself. The SC4 may use M&S coding, but at it's heart is the same powerful cell as in the other top JOEMEEK compressors, which makes just about everything sound great! Another useful feature of the introduction of M&S a post-compression width control. This can be used as a 'trim' for stereo material, and can make a signal go from mono, right up to 200% in width. This makes the SC4 superlative for all kinds of recording studio, post production and broadcast setups, as the sounds generated will defy their underlying mathematical purity.

The SC4 is the best that photo optical compression and quality digital and analogue interfaces have to offer. It is units like the SC4 that turn project into professional studios.

It's JOEMEEK Company theory that 'big' sounds are only possible if the recording process keeps the response and phase of the lower frequencies flat and under control. The JOEMEEK VC7 achieves this by maintaining an extended frequency range down below 8Hz (when the filter is selected to 'flat'). This ensures that there are no sudden phase shifts in the low end. The proof of the theory is that the sound from the VC7 is characteristically full bodied and rounded in character. Such extreme LF response can often bring its own problems so a precision high pass filter with a suitable range of frequencies is fitted per channel.
