The new Xciter lighting controller from Martin closes the circle on total performance control.

The Xciter provides complete functionality to your fingertips, enabling you to customize the mood and enhance your sounds through lighting that fits the pace and feel of every moment.

Effortless programming creates dependable, customised shows; while spontaneous overrides and cues allow you to always be prepared for the unexpected.

From the most personal show to mid-sized performances, the Xciter puts you in total control



### The X FX

With Xciter, lighting and effect triggers are no longer confined to simple BPM's. The Xciter sports leading edge technology that allows different fixtures to follow base, mids or highs, in fact all spectrums of your music; giving greater pronouncement to individual rhythms and giving you a complete and dynamic show.

### Nowhere to hide

Control up to 20 fixtures, each with up to 48 channels - with a maximum of 512 channels! (This will shortly be increased to an amazing 40 fixtures through a simple software update). This level of total light command empowers you to influence your audience far beyond the boundaries of the dance floor. And programming is a breeze with a joystick for manual pan and tilt guidance.

### Fade to Flash

Assign effects, scenes or dimmers to any of six faders and flash buttons and access them live during playback. You can also set the Grand Master Fader for overall light intensity and Pitch Fader to get pulses racing; speeding your show by up to five times when the moment dictates.



### Live control

Let your impulses take over. Improvise and match the mood with instant pitch adjustment, freeze, flash, blackout, master fader and more. Xciter gives you unprecedented spontaneity with six general faders and two masters, six flash and four customised buttons. Every cue, every effect, every fixture for every beat, is now just a hand reach away.

### Custom buttons

Functions such as strobe, smoke, mirror ball activation and more can be allocated to each of four programmable buttons for simplified effects juggling.



### Streamline

The Xciter's excellence is not exclusive to within. Martin has matched ingenuity and functionality with grace and aesthetics. Cool blue LCD displays lend both kudos and an easy navigation for Xciter's show menu, dialogue and fader label screens. A jog wheel also delivers a friendly scrolling function through fader pages while a joystick simplifies the manual pan and tilt control.



### Data Dispatch

Connect your PC directly to Xciter via the USB connection to update fixture libraries, to back up, edit, export and import shows.
