These front-loading VTRs accept both standard and mini size cassettes. The DSR-45 also offers a full range of analog audio (4 independent channels), and video I/Os, as well as RS422A and RS232C interfaces.

- A 123,200 pixel built-in LCD monitor for monitoring the camera picture, playback of the recorded picture, or viewing menu settings. The monitor can also display the levels for the four channels of audio. The audio levels can be viewed separately, or as an overlay above the picture.
- Both VTRs accommodate the two industry standard sizes of DVCAM and DV videocassette tapes; standard size and mini DV size.
- A digital tape counter display is supplied on the front panel, convenient for performing relative time code data editing and monitoring the operation of the unit.
- Built-in color bar signal generators are accessible through the user menu. (NOTE: Color bars are not compatible to SMPTE Standards.)
- When connected to another compatible VTR or camcorder with the i.LINK (DV I/O) connection, a push of the DUB key button initiates dubbing of the original tape and its time code.
- The DSR-25 has the ability to record and playback PAL signals
