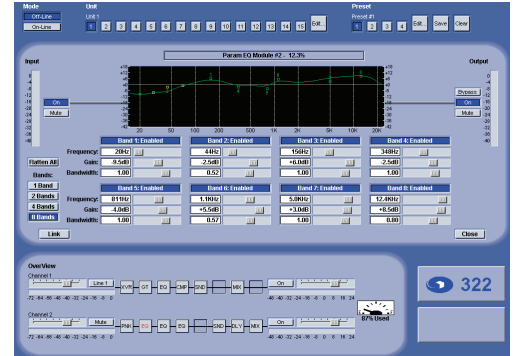
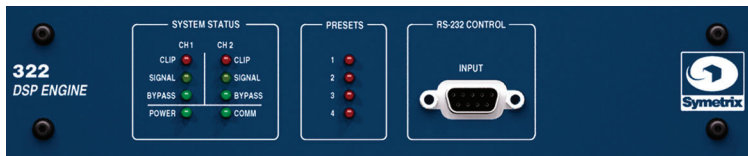

Did you know the 322 can do that?

Even before the untimely demise of the Symetrix 421m and 422, the 322 was filling their shoes. It is currently the recommended replacement for both, keeping in mind the following comparison:

| <p>322:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Analog I/O, Digital Processing (24-bit / 48 kHz)• Euroblock I/O• Four presets• Hands off - setup from supplied Windows GUI, no front panel control. Hook up standard pots for simple user control.• Can operate as dual mono or stereo
• More AGC control, faster reacting, sidechain filter, multiple dynamics modes• Occupies less space, rack two side-by-side in a single rack space for four channels of AGC per rack space• Also features Filters, Parametric EQ, Compression, Gating, Crossover, Delay, Mixing/Bussing, Noise Generator | <p>421m/422:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Analog• XLR and 1/4" I/O• No presets• Front panel controls, simple for those who know how to use them, dangerous for those who don't• Two 421m's required for stereo, waste a channel on 422 when used as mono (422 can not function as dual mono)• Limited AGC control, slow ramp time after extended silence
• Mic input (on 421m - add a 302 to the 322, racked side-by-side, occupies less space (1U) than equivalent two 421m's (2U))• One trick ponies |
