

PROGRAMMING

Autodials

To store outside numbers,

- 1. Press ITCM * * 1.
- 2. Press a programmable button. Hear fast tone.
- 3. Either:
- · Select a line by pressing a line button, or
- If you want to use the assigned prime line or the last line you used, just go on to Step 4 without pressing a button here.
- 4. Dial number to be stored (up to 15 digits).
 - Digits 0-9, *, # can be stored.
 - · Hookflash can be stored by pressing TAP.
 - Pause can be stored by pressing HOLD.
