

Modular ICS Central Answering Position User Card

## The central answering position

The Meridian Norstar<sup>\*</sup> central answering position (CAP) consists of a Norstar M7324 telephone and one or two CAP modules. A CAP module is an add-on device that provides 48 extra memory or line buttons for an M7324 telephone. You can connect up to two CAP modules to an M7324 telephone.

Your telephone is assigned as a central answering position by your installer or customer service representative.

Checking the pre-assigned CAP module buttons	<ul> <li>You can check what is programmed on any of your telephone or CAP module buttons.</li> <li>1. Press Feature * 0.</li> <li>2. Press the buttons you want to check and read the display.</li> <li>3. Ensure that your buttons have the correct snap-on caps.</li> <li>4. Press Feature when you are finished.</li> </ul>	
Customizing your CAP module	You can program any of the buttons on your CAP module that do not select lines. These buttons can be programmed to automatically dial internal or external numbers. You can also program features onto CAP module buttons. See your <i>M7324 Telephone User Card</i> for information on programming memory buttons.	
Monitoring telephones	The indicators beside internal autodial buttons on your CAP module show you the status of Norstar telephones.

	when a telephone has Do Not Disturb turned on	when a telephone has a call on hold and no other active call
Answering and transferring a call	Most of the telephone calls which you deal with should involve the following procedures:	
	<ol> <li>Answer a call made from outside the Norstar system.</li> <li>Determine whom the call is for.</li> </ol>	
	<ol> <li>Check the status of the destination Norstar telephone.</li> </ol>	
	4. If the indicator is off, transfer the call to that telephone.	
	If you answer a call for a co-worker who is busy on another call, Norstar offers you some useful features:	
	<ul> <li>Camp-on lets you transfer the call to them.</li> <li>Ring Again lets you know when the telephone becomes free.</li> <li>Priority Call lets you interrupt their current call.</li> <li>Message lets you send them notification to call you.</li> </ul>	
	If your telephone has been assigned as a central answering position, you can send up to 30 messages to co-workers.
